His Carnegie Hall with tin walls is the Goodstone Aircraft Company - an oily amalgam of all the places where he has sweated it out on the shopfloor - where each man has to be a virtuoso able to temper brute force with hair s-breadth delicacy. This new book includes some poems from his earlier collection Goodstone (1991), but draws on ten more years of life in the factory, a bastion of male America where bragging men dominate and cheat each other, boasting of their sexual conquests while trying to come to terms with sexual failure. In this tense, abrasive, rowdy atmosphere, suppressed violence, male bravado and sexual harassment go hand in hand. And when the wounded male lashes out, Voss is there.
