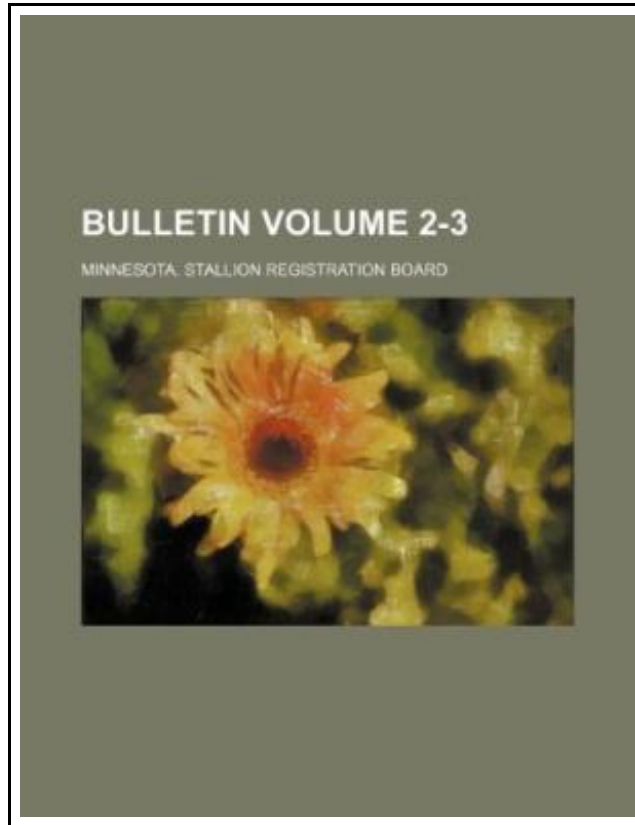

I talked with a man--who had five stallions on the road last summer and he told me that the horse business never looked better to him than right now, and I think my horse will have all he can do this coming season. Times and methods are changing in all lines of business and the stallion owner must realize this and meet the changing conditions if he wants to make a success of standing a public-service stallion or jack.
