So well did this arrangement work, that Dr. Becker, favoured by the unusually fine summer, by remaining on the hill every night succeeded in recording no fewer than forty-eight sunsets or sunrises in the months of June and July. The observations are the more valuable, as about the beginning of August heavy rains set in, and the weather in general was so unfavourable that only two sunrises, and not a single sunset, were observable in that month. Nor did the skies improve much before the end of the year, for in the last ten weeks there were but five nights on which nebulae could be observed in the meridian, while the fifteen first weeks of the year yielded seventeen nights suitable for that class of work.
